LEARN TO SCUBA DIVE

Your underwater adventure begins when you learn to scuba dive! Turn your diving fantasy into a reality; explore the vast wonders of the underwater world. Give yourself a chance to delve into the past, by immersing yourself amongst the numerous shipwrecks resting on the ocean floor, or just relax and hover over the beautiful coral reefs. You can watch the fish glide by, see marine animals; sharks, whales, seals, rays and so much more, all in their own environment! Let Scuba Network be your gateway to these and many other adventures, both here and abroad!

THREE Easy Steps to become an Open Water Diver:

- **First- Complete your Agency e-learning course & attend two Classroom sessions**
The online e-learning course will replace textbooks and knowledge review exams and can be taken at your own pace (**e-learning must be completed BEFORE attending pool** & within 6 months of activation). Two classroom sessions consist of a review of the online material and a hands-on review of equipment and dive skills.
- Second- Attend 3 Pool Sessions**
Experience the excitement as you learn to breathe underwater in a controlled setting, before going to the ocean. Progressive mastery of diving skills is both challenging and rewarding, and our instructors will be there the whole way to ensure your journey is safe, fun and an adventure!
- Third- Engage in 4 Open Water Dives over at least two days**
Four open water dives in a lake or ocean and an optional snorkeling dive with an instructor are required to complete your certification process. This is the capstone of your training and your ticket to the exploring the underwater world! Take these here on Long Island or join us on one of our Dive Trips. We can also refer you on your own dive destination vacation! **These dives must be completed within one year of the class and pool session.**

TWO Simple Requirements:

- **Good Physical Condition**
You must be in reasonably good health, with no significant medical history (epilepsy, diabetes, ear disorders, asthma, heart or respiratory conditions, recent or "long" COVID)- or you require a doctor's medical clearance -see the RSTC Medical Questionnaire. You must also be at least 10 years of age.
- **Basic Swimming Skills**
Comfort and mobility in the water is a must to dive. A basic ability to swim and tread water are needed to safely dive below the surface.

ONE last thing before you start:

- **Equipment Mask, Snorkel, Fins and Booties.**
Every student must have their own Mask, Fins, Snorkel, Booties, and a few other personal use items. We recommend that your purchase these with Scuba network's friendly, informative sales staff. All of these items are available at discount prices and come with an in-water guarantee during your pool course. These items must be suitable for scuba diving and fitted to you.

- Weight Belt and Weights - Slate and Diver Logbook - Wetsuit (recommended) - Mesh Bag (recommended)

\$349.99 * Open Water Pool & Classroom Course (students receive a discount of 10% towards the in-shop purchase of Mask-Fins-Snorkel-Booties, and 15% towards the purchase of a wetsuit) – this fee **does not** include the **Agency e-learning fee** or the **Open Water Certification Dive fee**. Private and Semi-Private lessons additional.
